Baleadas Currently Daniel's niece, Amy, is visiting us and helping out, not only around the house, but also with the ministry. We invited a sweet lady from the church named Belkis to teach us how to make baleadas, a typical Honduran dish. Below is a link to a video detailing the process. Just a note: It is hard to get an actual recipe from the women here. They are amazing cooks, but the recipes are generally not written down, but instead passed down from generation to generation by watching their own mothers and grandmothers cook. Because of this, some of the measurements in the recipe included in the video are a rough estimate. When making the tortillas, they will add more of certain ingredients if the consistency is not just right. We hope you enjoy them as much as Justus does!
