Trip to the Caves

The Honduran school year calendar runs from early February to mid-November. Because the students were about to return to classes, we decided to rent a bus last month and take the church members to the Caves of Talgua in Catacamas, a larger town further east in the department of Olancho. During our time there, we had a Bible lesson on Psalm 57, one of the Psalms David wrote while hiding from Saul in a cave. The application was that we can worship God even in the most dire situations.

A fun fact about the caves is that they are called "The Caves of the Glowing Skulls." In one high chamber that is not open to the public yet, archaeologists have found skeletal remains which date back to 700 BC (or even older). The cave got its nickname because the bones shine due to being covered in calcite deposits.





Ladies' Meeting With Rachel's pregnancy and the birth of little Chloe, we had taken a break from the bimonthly ladies meetings, but we are excited to be starting that up again. This past month we were encouraged by a large group showing up to hear a Bible lesson on slander from Titus 2 as well as enjoy some fellowship with food and games.
